Please remember to bring the necessary documents, outlined below:

❖ Personal Information

- Photo ID (driver's license, passport, or another form of identification)
- **Insurance Cards** (both primary and secondary insurance, if applicable)

❖ Medical Records

- Referral Letter from your primary care physician or referring specialist (if applicable)
- Previous Neurosurgical or Medical Reports related to your condition (if available)
- Hospital Discharge Summaries from any recent hospital stays related to your condition

Imaging and Test Results

- Copies of Recent Imaging Studies (MRI, CT scans, X-rays, etc.), including both:
 - o Digital copies on CD/DVD or USB drive (if available)
- Lab Results or Diagnostic Test Reports relevant to your condition
- Blood Test Results (if ordered by a referring physician)

❖ Medication List

- Current List of Medications (including dosage and frequency)
- Include over-the-counter medications, supplements, and herbal remedies

❖ Symptom and Medical History Documentation

- Symptom Log (record any symptoms, how long you've had them, and their severity)
- List of Surgeries or Procedures (including dates and results, especially if related to the brain or spine)

Allergy Information

• List of Known Allergies (especially to medications, contrast dyes, or latex)

Insurance and Payment Information

- Co-payment or Deductible Payment Method (if required)
- List of Authorized Persons who can discuss your medical details (if needed)

Questions or Concerns for the Neurosurgeon

• A **written list of questions** you want to ask the neurosurgeon (e.g., regarding your diagnosis, treatment options, risks, recovery time)

❖ Notebook and Pen

• To take notes during your appointment regarding the diagnosis, treatment options, and next steps.

Support Person (Optional)

• **Bring a family member or friend** for support, to help remember details, or assist with mobility, if needed.
